## **Year 6 Visit to Styal Mill**

As part of the Year 6 Autumn Term Theme of Victorians, we have arranged a visit to Styal Mill on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> November.

During the day, the children will be taken by Tour Guides around the Mill to learn what it was like to work as a child in the 1800's. They will also be taken to the school rooms and will experience a typical lesson. To enhance their understanding, we would like the children to dress in Victorian costume, details of which are as follows:

Girls: Long dark skirt, flat dark shoes, white blouse, hair in plaits or bun and a bonnet (optional).

Boys: Dark trousers (short if possible), knee high socks, white shirt, flat cap (optional) and dark shoes.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks) in a named plastic bag. This may be ordered from our kitchen by completing a "packed lunch order form" no later than Monday 20<sup>th</sup> November. This costs £2.50 and should be paid via your ParentPay account. If you are entitled to a free school meal a packed lunch can be provided free of charge but should still be ordered in advance.

The children will leave school at approximately 9am and will be back by  $3.30 \, \text{pm}$ . The cost of the trip will be £9.45. These visits are designed to enhance the curriculum, without sufficient contributions this trip will not be able to go ahead.
